moving CHECKLIST

NOTIFY OF ADDRESS CHANGE

- Post office
- Bank
- Credit card companies
- Insurance companies: medical and auto
- Mortgage company
- Utility companies: power, gas, water/sewer/trash
- DMV: Registration, Driver license
- School(s) and Doctor offices
- Pharmacy (transfer prescriptions)
- Home delivery subscriptions

MOVING DAY

- Carry currency, jewelry, and important documents on your person or in your vehicle.
- Let friends and/or family know your route and estimated time of arrival.
- Double-check cupboards, closets, attic, and shed.
- Leave any miscellaneous keys for the new owners (garage, mailbox, etc.)

MOVING WITH PETS?

- Get a copy of your pet's vet records along with rabies and vaccine certifications.
- Make sure their license tags are secure and that your contact info is current.
- Consider boarding your pets during the actual moving days to reduce anxiety.
- Allow them plenty of time to acclimate to your new home and neighborhood; it could take a few days or even weeks.
- Carry a current photograph in case they are lost during - or shortly after - the move.

Moving long distance?

- Gather their leash, water, kennel, and toys for the car ride.
- Contact the State Veterinarian in your new location to learn that state's requirements.
- Research pet-friendly accommodations if an overnight stay is required.

Bonus/Safety Tip!

Change the locks of your new home as well as any garage and/or door codes to ensure security once you've moved in!
